The first complete edition of Washington Irving dates back to 1834 (Chicago : Belford, Clarke, 10 vol.) ; in 1861, two years after his death, his works are republished in 21 volumes by G.-P. Putnam in New York. Between 1969 et 1989, the University of Madison Press published a modernized version of his complete works in 30 volumes.
